Race Numbers

- Small numbers must be fixed on the upper forearm (left and right).
- Back number must be fixed at the **left side**.

Transponders

- Return at the UCI blue tent (finish area).
- Failure to return the transponder will result in a 100 euros charge.

80% Rule

Any rider whose time being 80% slower of that of the race leader's first lap will be pulled out of the race, except when the rider is on the final lap.

Tyres

The width of the tyre (measured between the widest parts) shall not exceed **33 mm** and may not incorporate any form of spike or stud.

Outfit

Riders are required to wear the outfit as indicated on the start lists:

WCh: World Champion - WCL: World Cup Leader - NCh: National Champion - N: National Outfit

Start

- The start will be given **by lights** (red > green).
- Riders causing false start will be DSQ.

Prize Money

- Top 50 men elite - Top 25 women - Top 20 men U23

- Top 15 men juniors
Paid in cash after the race, **Oud Schooltje** (see map on page 2)

Travel Allowances

- For national teams men U23 and men juniors (except BEL)
- Paid in cash after the race, **Oud Schooltje** (see map on page 2)

Doping Control

- The riders to be tested will be notified by a chaperone.
- There will be a list with the race numbers of the selected riders on the door of the doping control station **military base E19** (see map on page 2) and at the finish line.
