Course

Length: 2600 m Pit 1: 805 m Pit 2: 2280 m Total elevation: 30 m

Green bracelet mandatory for all riders.

Race Numbers

- The small numbers must be fixed on the upper forearms
- The numbers must not be cut or altered
- The back number must be fixed at the LEFT side.

Tyres

• The width of the tyre, maximum 33 mm.

Outfit

Riders are required to wear the outfit as indicated on the start lists: WCh: World Champion - WCL World Cup Leader -CCh: Continental Champion (EUR mandatory - PAN optional) - NCh: National Champion - N National outfit

Start

- Start countdown: 3' 2' 1' 30" "Heart beat sound" 30" to the start
- The start will be given by lights (red > green), riders causing a false start will be DSQ.

Pit area

- A rider may only take the pit lane to change his bicycle, wheel(s) or for other mechanical assistance (Art 5.1.038), penalty: DSQ.
- Use of electrical personal washers in the pit area is forbidden

Parking

3 parking zones

Ceremony

- Top 3 riders + World Cup leader for Men Junior, Under 23,
- Top 3 riders + World Cup leader for Women AND Women Under 23

Transponders including GPS tracker

- Its use is mandatory
- Return in the finish zone, volunteers with red bibs
- Failure to return will result in a 150 € charge

Prize Money

- Prize money all categories
 - Bank transfer
 - Fill out form that is in your envelope
 - Prize money form to be send by email or post
- Travel allowances for Men U23 and Men Junior (except GER)
 - paid by cash
 - at the TU5 Zeven
 - Saturday from 11.30 -13.30
 - show a personal ID
- Fastest lap awards paid by the UCI (all categories)

Anti-doping Control

- Located near start/finish truck, behind the podium.
- The riders to be tested will be notified by a chaperone.
- There will be a list at the entrance of the doping control station and at the finish line.
